Fine-tuning our bulletin and putting out a newsletter are all meant to help foster effective communication. We want to keep you informed as best we can about all the many great things that are happening at St. Charles and St. Peter. The newsletter, because it is mailed directly to all parish households, reaches those who many not be here at Mass for various reasons. It's a gentle reminder of what they may be missing out on in terms of parish life.

Of course, communication is a two way street. In the church we have both formal and informal ways by which the parish priest seeks and receives input from his parishioners. The formal method includes the established consultative bodies - Pastoral and Finance Councils, and various parish committees. Right now both Pastoral Councils are beginning to look at our parish mission statements. I am now meeting monthly with our Finance Councils. And I am prayerfully considering how our whole process of consultation can work more effectively - and how St. Peter and St. Charles can better collaborate with each other in proclaiming the Gospel to all.
